Accident Reports



To get an Accident Report, please go to crashdocs.org. Follow the directions on the website. Your accident report number should have the four-digit year and eight numbers after. If your accident number is 2023-12345 you will enter 2023-00012345 if it is 2023-1234 you will enter 2023-00001234. You will need to add the zeros or it will not pull up for you.

It can take up to ten (10) business days for your report to be uploaded to CrashDocs.
