FLOOD PLAIN PREVENTION

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 277, Dated January 9, 1995 to change date of Flood Insurance Study, and with accompanying flood insurance rate maps (DFIRM):

An Ordinance amending Article I Sec. 8.5-7 and Article II Sec. 8.5-21 and Sec. 8.5-22 Flood Plain Prevention.

WHEREAS, the Bloomfield City Council has determined that it is necessary and desirable to amend Article I Sec. 8.5-7 and Article II Sec. 8.5-21 and Sec. 8.5-22 #6 Flood Plain Prevention.

ARTICLE I Sec. 8.5-7 Basis for establishing the areas of special flood hazard.

The areas of special flood hazard identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled "The Flood Insurance Study for City of Bloomfield," dated *August 8, 2010* within accompanying flood insurance rate maps (DFIRM) and any revisions thereto are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this chapter. (Ord. No. 199, 1 (Art. III, B) 3-23-87)

ARTICLE II Sec. 8.5-21 Designation of the floodplain administrator.

The City Manager will appoint a designated floodplain administrator to administer and implement the provisions of this chapter and other appropriate sections of 44 CFR (National Flood Insurance Program Regulations) pertaining to floodplain management. (Ord. No 199 1 (Art. IV, A), 3-23-87)

ARTICLE II Sec. 8.5-22 #6 Duties and responsibilities of floodplain administrator.

6. Notifying in riverine situations, adjacent communities and the state coordination agency which is Emergency Management Planning and Coordination as the State Coordinating Agency, prior to any alteration or relocation of a watercourse, and submitting evidence of such notification to the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY of the City of Bloomfield amends the Bloomfield Municipal Code Flood Damage Prevention.
