Intent to Adopt Ordinance

The City of Bloomfield, New Mexico, hereby intends to adopt Ordinance No. 481 at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on Monday, May 13, 2019.

ORDINANCE NO. 481

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 54, 107, 126, 127, 135, 148, 159, 168, 173, 175, 182, 184, 197, 200, 206, 210, 212, 241, 243, 244, 250, 278, 286, 287, 288, 306, 308, 315, 330, 352, 353, 369, 387B, 388, 393, 402, 418, 424, 475, RELATING TO THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD UTILITIES.

WHEREAS, Chapter Eighteen (18) of the Bloomfield Municipal Code governs utilities within the City of Bloomfield; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomfield desires to revise and update the following provisions contained within Chapter Eighteen (18) of the Bloomfield Municipal Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD THAT THE FOLLOWING REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO CHAPTER EIGHTEEN (18) OF THE BLOOMFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT UPON ADOPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE. OTHER THAN THE CHANGES SET FORTH HEREIN, ALL OTHER PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN CHAPTER EIGHTEEN (18) REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT:

Sec. 18-16. – Definitions

“Bloomfield Irrigation District (BID) Transportation Fee is a unit rate charge per customer account for the cost of transportation of water as charged to the City of Bloomfield by the Bloomfield Irrigation District (BID). The Bloomfield Irrigation District (BID) Transportation Fee is in addition to any other charges and/or rates relating to usage of City of Bloomfield water and/or waste water.”

Except for the changes set forth above, the provisions of 18-16 of the Bloomfield Municipal Code are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sec. 18-18. - Water rates.

“A Bloomfield Irrigation District (BID) Transportation Fee is hereby made a part of the current rate structure and shall be applied to each customer account. From the effective date of this Ordinance through December 31, 2019, a Bloomfield Irrigation District (BID) Transportation Fee of \$0.25 per thousand gallons of water used for each customer account is hereby made a part of the current rate structure. For the timeframe of January 1, 2020, onward, a Bloomfield Irrigation District (BID) Transportation Fee of \$0.30 per thousand gallons of water used for each customer account is hereby made a part of the rate structure for the time period of January 1, 2020, and thereafter.”

Except for the changes set forth above, the provisions of 18-18 of the Bloomfield Municipal Code are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sec. 18-26. – Water connection required.

“(f) The owner, agent, tenant, lessee, or any other person who commits, takes part in assists, or allows any violation of Section 18-26 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both fine and imprisonment. Each and every day that such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the city from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation.”

Except for the changes set forth above, the provisions of 18-26 of the Bloomfield Municipal Code are hereby ratified and confirmed.


Sec. 18-36. – Connection to sewer system required.

“(f) The owner, agent, tenant, lessee, or any other person who commits, takes part in assists, or allows any violation of Section 18-36 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both fine and imprisonment. Each and every day that such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the city from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation.”


Except for the changes set forth above, the provisions of 18-36 of the Bloomfield Municipal Code are hereby ratified and confirmed.
