AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 54, 107, 126, 127, 135, 148, 159, 168, 173, 175, 182, 184, 197, 200, 206, 210, 212, 241, 243, 244, 250, 278, 286, 287, 288, 306, 308, 315, 330, 352, 353, 369, 387B, 388, 393, 402, 418, 424, 475, and 481 RELATING TO THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD UTILITIES.

WHEREAS, Chapter Eighteen (18) of the Bloomfield Municipal Code governs utilities within the City of Bloomfield; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomfield desires to revise and update the following provisions contained within Chapter Eighteen (18) of the Bloomfield Municipal Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD THAT THE FOLLOWING REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO CHAPTER EIGHTEEN (18) OF THE BLOOMFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT UPON ADOPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE. OTHER THAN THE CHANGES SET FORTH HEREIN, ALL OTHER PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN CHAPTER EIGHTEEN (18) REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT:

Sec. 18-18. – Water rates.


“(c) Automatic adjustment. Beginning in calendar year 2020, no later than October 15 of each year, the City Manager shall:

1. Notify the City Council that under this section, an automatic increase in water rates shall take place equal to the current change in the Consumer Price Index (Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Consumer Price Index-All Urban Consumers, Water and Sewerage Maintenance (CPI) or its equivalent successor index) over the previous 12-month period ending the previous July 1 and what the proposed increase will be in the form of a percentage increase; and
2. Publish in a newspaper of general circulation and post in the City Hall lobby and on the City's web-site a notice providing what the proposed increase would be and stating that the proposed increase will be effective on December 1 of that year unless the City Council, by affirmative action, adopts a motion cancelling the proposed increase on or before November 15 of that year.

Unless the City Council, by affirmative action taken on or before November 15, cancels the implementation of the new proposed rates, the proposed increase based on the change in the CPI will take effect and shall be reflected on all water charges billed after December 1 of that year.”


Except for the changes set forth above, the provisions of 18-18 of the Bloomfield Municipal Code are hereby ratified and confirmed.




