THREE PARCELS:

FORMER AEREX REFINERY-REFINED CRUDE OIL TO PRODUCE GASOLINE, KEROSENE, AND OTHER PETROLEUM PRODUCTS.

OPERATED FROM 1932-1960'S. DISMANTLED IN THE 1980'S.

PARCEL 1: STILL OPEN CASE WITH OIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT (OCD). OWNER IS STILL RESPONSIBLE FOR CLOSURE.

PARCELS 2 AND 3: BEING ASSESSED BY NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT (NMED) WITH BROWNFIELD GRANT FUNDS.



PARCEL 1: PER NMED: ON-GOING "BIOVENTING"

SOIL AND GROUNDWATER CONTAMINATION

OCD MUST GRANT A CLOSURE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR BROWNFIELDS GRANT

NEED TO WORK WITH MARATHON OIL TO GAIN ACCESS FOR ASSESSMENT WORK

PARCEL 3:

PHASE I SITE ASSESSMENT FUNDED BY EPA WAS COMPLETED IN NOVEMBER 2019.

A FOLLOW-UP PHASE II ASSESSMENT IS PLANNED FOR WINTER 2020 TO DEFINE SUBSURFACE CONTAMINATION.





BROWNFIELDS PROGRAM:

ALREADY FUNDED PHASE I AND WORKING ON PHASE II SITE ASSESSMENTS.

WORKING TOWARD A EPA CLEAN-UP GRANT APPLICATION TO CLEAN UP THE SITE FOR AN INTENDED USE.

NEED TO ENGAGE OWNER OF PARCEL 1.



NEXT STEPS:

WITH SUPPORT FROM BLOOMFIELD SCHOOLS TEACHERS, A VIRTUAL STUDENT WORKSHOP ORGANIZED FOR FALL/WINTER 2020 TO GATHER PROJECT IDEAS AND KEEP THE COMMUNITY ENGAGED DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

MAYOR HAS ASKED STUDENTS TO PRESENT THEIR IDEAS TO COUNCIL IN EARLY 2021.

HOLD COMMUNITY WORKSHOP TO GATHER PUBLIC INPUT ON THE RE-USE OF THE SITE – LOOK FOR THE WORKSHOP TO BE ADVERTISED IN SPRING 2021.

APPLY FOR A BROWNFIELDS CLEAN-UP GRANT IN OCTOBER 2021.
